

ACRYLIC TIP AND OVERLAY REVERSE FRENCH



STEP 1:

Sanitize your hands and the clients hands. Prepare the nail to the manufactures instructions. If removing the shine off the nail remember it is the shine with a Endurance 240 Grit File or buffer not thinning the nail plate and wipe with a Nail Wipe with Nailpure Plus.



STEP 2:

Apply the nail tip to the nail and blend. Size the tip so it fit the nail. Sidewalls should be straight not flared and the C curve to mirror the curve of the natural nail. Remove dust with a Plush Brush or with a Nail Wipe and Nailpure Plus.



STEP 3:

Apply Attraction Primer . This dehydrates the natural nail and promotes adhesion, preventing lifting of the artificial product from the natural nail plate. Apply your chosen Masquerade Color Acrylic to the nail plate creating a ledge which will form the smile line.



STEP 4:

To crispin the smile line you can file to create the ledge for your chosen Attraction White to butt up to. Remove the dust, if any and apply Pure White to the free edge. Ensure the corners of the French reach the edges.



STEP 5:

File into shape. Start with the sidewalls. Make sure they are parallel and not fanning out. File the nail so it is smooth balanced and attractive following the curvature of the nail.



STEP 6:

To finish either buff to a high shine or seal with Glaze 'n Go and cure in any full hand UV lamp for 90 seconds. Apply Nurture Oil to the cuticle and massage in to complete the service.
